TASTE OF CHINA: CHINESE ART LESSONS

Date and time: To be arranged

Duration: 2 hours per session

Frequency: Bi-weekly or Monthly

Class Size: 1 - 3 adult students

Level

Beginner to intermediate

Objectives

1. Build confidence in making Chinese brush strokes
2. Compose a complete Chinese painting with popular Chinese motifs and calligraphy
3. Apply Chinese techniques in contemporary Western watercolour painting, using both Chinese ink and Western watercolour paint

Structure

1. Focus on various brush stroke techniques, with coaching from tutor tailored to each individual's level
2. A new motif is introduced at each session, e.g. bamboo, panda, peony, plum blossom, goldfish, bird, landscape
3. Chinese art and culture appreciation depending on each student's interests, e.g. Chinese paper cutting, Ming dynasty vase, silk, lacquered furniture, folk music, oriental interior design

Complimentary Dim Sum and Blossoming Tea

As part of Chinese tradition, dim sum* and Chinese blossoming tea are provided by the host as courtesy without additional cost. This is optional and can be served during break and after session.
