





## queue 辣子 biànzi

### Origin

- The queue or cue is a **hairstyle** **发型** (*fǎxíng*) worn by Han Chinese and others under **Manchu rule** in the 17th century. It was later required to be worn by male subjects of **Qing Dynasty** **清朝** (*qīngcháo*).
- Hair on top of the scalp is grown long and is often braided, while the front portion of the head is shaved.


### Resistance

- Initially there was resistance to wear queue (nicknamed "pigtail"), opinions about the queue did change over time.
- Traditionally, adult Han Chinese did not cut their hair for philosophical and cultural reasons. According to Confucius ideology, we owe our body to our parents and we ought not to damage it in the name of **filial piety** **孝顺** (*xiàoshùn*).


